New Media & Extended Learning, a department of Extended University, is looking for a flexible, talented professional with the desire and ability to support online courses, while developing his or her skills in the position of Professional Intern with the NMEL Course Development and Faculty Support Group. The person selected for this position will be under the direct supervision and mentorship of a senior Instructional Media Specialist (Course Designer) and will provide a wide range of technical and operational support for the development of online courses in UNM Learn, Blackboard 9.1, as well as faculty training and user support.

The primary focus of this position is as an entry-level course designer who undertakes a range of on-going development and production of web based courses and support for faculty. The position requires knowledge and expertise of Instructional Design and Distance Education gained through the completion of a Bachelor's or Master's Degree.

The Intern will work under the guidance of a Senior Course Designer, in developing, building and supporting online courses for UNM Main Campus. The Intern will assist Senior Course Designers in working with faculty to analyze needs and determine goals, objectives and appropriate delivery methods, as well as media for instruction in the online environment. This may include tasks such as instructional design, online course production, technical and operational support, multimedia development, course migration, training documentation, training faculty and some student technical support.

The ideal candidate will be a self-starter with excellent verbal and written communication skills, a strong understanding of educational strategies and familiarity with online pedagogical strategies. They will have a customer service focus, strong computer skills, including creating content for the web, and training adults. The successful candidate will be a quick learner who can adapt to training and production needs as they arise. This person will be self-motivated in

maintaining a current knowledge of the latest hardware and software technologies, as well as best practices for online learning and will possess strong organizational skills.

This is a developmental, fixed term (typically 1-2 years) career-path position restricted to graduates of accredited university Bachelors or Masters programs who have obtained their degrees, no earlier than 24 months prior to the date of hire.

Required bachelor's may be either BA or BS.

This is a 12 month per year, staff position that works onsite at UNM Main Campus. This is a two year term position, updated yearly. Funding available through 06/30/2014; continuance beyond that date is subject to the Department's operational needs as outlined in UBPPM.

**Minimum Qualifications:**
